APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS

- Student must have excellent attendance record.
- Student must display excellent citizenship.
- Student must achieve All-A Honor Roll for all completed semesters in the 2020-2021 school year.
- Student must be currently enrolled in the 2020-2021 academic year and have enrolled and completed an Enrollment Agreement for the 2021-2022 academic year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Complete the New Foundation Scholarship application and submit by April 23rd.
- Complete registration & registration fee paid for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Complete 2021-2022 Enrollment Agreement.
- 2019-2020 tuition balance is current and has had no more than 3 late payments.
- **Grades Kinder through 6th.**
- Must complete an in-person interview with the scholarship committee.

DEADLINES

April 23rd – Scholarship applications due

April 23rd – Enrollment Agreements due for scholarship applicants

April 26th-30th – Scholarship interviews

Scholarship award letters mailed home shortly afterwards
