## St. Philip's Episcopal School Uniform Standards and Guidelines

Our school uniform supports a safe, respectful, and focused learning environment. It helps create a sense of unity and ensures students are dressed in a consistent, school-appropriate manner each day.

### Footwear

- Closed-toe shoes must be worn at all times.
- Sandals, flip-flops, and Crocs are not permitted.
- Footwear should be safe, appropriate for school activities, and not excessively bulky.

### Outerwear

- Sweaters and jackets may be worn during the school day for warmth.
- Outerwear may be any color.
- Families may choose to have outerwear embroidered with the school logo, though this is not required.
- Whenever possible, please label outerwear with the student's name.

### Cold Weather Additions

- Girls may wear black, navy, white, or red leggings, tights, or warm-up pants under skirts.
- Students may wear solid-colored turtlenecks or long-sleeve shirts under polo shirts or jumpers for added warmth.

### General Appearance and Grooming

To maintain a neat, respectful, and school-appropriate appearance:

- Hair should be clean, brushed, and neatly maintained.
- Extreme hair colors or distracting hairstyles are not permitted.
- Hair should be kept out of the face to support safety and learning.
- Shorts, skirts, and skorts should be no shorter than two inches above the knee when standing. Modesty shorts must be worn underneath skirts and jumpers.
- Make-up is not permitted for preschool and elementary students. Middle school students who choose to wear makeup must keep it subtle and natural. Heavy, dramatic, or age-inappropriate makeup is not permitted.
- Artificial nails, acrylic nails, and nail extensions are not permitted for preschool and elementary students. Middle school students may wear artificial nails if they are clean, well-maintained, and of a reasonable length. Nails that are excessively long, contain inappropriate images or language, or pose a safety concern are not permitted.
- Jewelry and accessories should be minimal and non-distracting.
- Clothing displaying images or themes related to violence, weapons, death, or other inappropriate content is prohibited.
- Jeans or other clothing with holes, tears, or excessive distressing are not permitted.
- Clothing and accessories should reflect a simple and consistent school appearance.
